National Civic Engagement Survey II Replication Survey Fall 2002

Data Codebook

Introduction

This survey was fielded from November 14 to 20 April 4, 2002 to May 20, 2002. It was designed and conducted by Molly Andolina, DePaul University; Scott Keeter, George Mason University and the Pew Research Center; Cliff Zukin, Rutgers University; and Krista Jenkins, Rutgers University (project manager). It was funded by The Pew Charitable Trusts.

The dataset associated with the Survey contains responses from 1,400 respondents ages 18 and older on 163 variables. This survey was one of three that formed the basis for the report [*The Civic and Political Health of the Nation: A Generational Portrait*](#), released September 19, 2002 by CIRCLE. The other two surveys that form the basis of this report are:

1. National Youth Survey of Civic Engagement, Spring 2002

Fielded: January 29 – February 25, 2002;
Sample Size: N=1,166;
Population: Ages 15 to 25.

2. National Civic Engagement Survey I, Spring 2002

Fielded: April 4 to May 20, 2002;
Sample Size: N=3,426;
Population: Age 15 and older.

Both surveys can be accessed on the CIRCLE web page, and are publicly available.

Methodology

This was a nationwide survey with a total sample of N=1,400 adults 18 and older that sought to replicate the results of the Spring 2002 National Civic Engagement Survey (NCES I). The main goal of this study was to assess the reliability of the 19 principal indicators of civic and political engagement detailed in NCES I. A

secondary goal was to further explore consumer behavior as a form of political expression.

The sample was divided evenly between two field houses; Schulman, Ronca & Bucuvalas, Inc. (SRBI) and Princeton Data Source (PDS); each did 700 interviews. NCES I was conducted by SRBI. For this survey, half of the interviews were conducted by a different organization in order to ensure that the measures were not vulnerable to so-called "house effects."

Using these Data

The National Civic Engagement Survey II, Fall 2002 is available in four data formats: STATA version 8, SPSS Windows format, SPSS Portable format, and SAS Transport format. Analyses with these data can also be conducted using our online Survey Documentation Analysis software.

Any analysis of these data require the use of a weighting variable. Weight variables are:

- Use "**weight**" when analyzing the total sample.
- Use "**pweight**" when analyzing data from PDS.
- Use "**sweight**" when analyzing data from SRBI.

The "qcondist" variable refers to the congressional district of the respondent. This variable needs to be filtered on the "state" variable in order for the congressional district to be listed. A guide to the most recent congressional districts is located on the website below. Please note that the boundaries of some districts may be different now than in 2002.
